This course is designed for **teachers and teaching assistants** who work with pupils with SEND, including those with complex or severe learning difficulties in mainstream classrooms

**It is often difficult to plan and deliver curriculum RE for pupils with SEND. Finding ways of 'making it real' for them provides a great deal of challenge, time and resources.**

The aims of this course are:

- To **introduce Mediated Learning Experiences** as a way of helping pupils to enter into meaningful learning in RE
- To share a **range of materials and resources** to support teachers and teaching assistants.
- To **allow planning time to 'tailor' the RE schemes of work** currently used in schools to the individual needs of pupils with SEND. This will require participants to **bring with them their schemes of work and the lesson planning format** they use. The intention is to support planning a series of lessons based around the model of Mediated Learning Experiences for specific pupils.

Margaret Wright currently works for the Diocese of Lancaster Education Service as an LLDE. As well as supporting a specific group of schools she also delivers CPD to schools on Religious Education and Prayer and Liturgy in the primary phase.
