This course is **for teachers, chaplains and those involved in prayer and liturgy**. The course is aimed predominantly at Primary Schools but colleagues in High Schools may well be able to develop the ideas for older age groups.

The course is offered before Easter to enable schools to develop and plan ideas in advance of the Summer Term.

Through this course, teachers will have an opportunity to:

- **Reflect on the gospel account of the road to Emmaus through Scripture, art and music.**
- **Support the school community in entering into the mystery of Easter and the Diocesan Year of the Eucharist.**
- **Plan a prayer journey using the gospel account to provide 'stopping places' or stations around the environment of the school which can be used after Easter. Those attending are asked to bring a map of the local area around the school.**
