The Postgraduate Catholic Leadership Programme (PGCLP)

"I have been inspired by the speakers, like-minded colleagues and the core leadership team of the programme". (PGCLP delegates 2018)

The PGCLP is a new programme which has run successfully for the past two years. It revisits and builds upon the great success of the Catholic Leadership Programme. There is clearly an appetite for refreshing the spirituality, understanding of mission and the network of support experienced during the CLP. One delegate from 2017 wrote: *"I wish I could continue having a regular opportunity to engage with a programme that encourages further reflection. I wish the CLP could be on-going for the rest of my career as a support through the difficult and challenging times"*

To date the delegates have found the programme to be of great worth both personally and professionally, as one wrote in June 2018: *"It has revived my faith and renewed my inner strength".*

The PGCLP has been designed for staff holding a senior leadership post in their school who have completed the CLP. It will run from January to November 2019 and there will be:

- four evening sessions with a speaker
- a one-day conference at Liverpool Hope University
- two residential conferences at Whalley Abbey
- at least three one-to-one sessions with a mentor
- opportunities for reading, reflection and interpretation with peers led by an experienced education professional with a deep understanding of formation.

The cost of the programme will be £900 for the year.
